Subject: Math

Observe the following things in your surroundings :(Write the answers or draw the pictures on a paper and bring after holidays.)

- Which animal is BIG? Which animal is SMALL?
- Which fruit has MORE seeds? Which fruit has LESS seeds?
- Which tree is TALLER than a mango tree? Which tree is SHORTER than a palm tree?
- Which vegetable is HEAVY? Which vegetable is LIGHT?
- Which number is GREATER than 8? Which number is LESSER than 8?

The above under line concepts are very important in math. So if the child understand these concepts at this age, it will be helpful in their future math. Please help your child to understand them.

Subject: E.V.S

Help the child to do GERMINATION at home. Encourage them to know the importance of plants in our life.

Follow the steps given bellow to do germination.

- Take a small plastic cup or small pot.
- Pour some soil (take out the weeds and make it smooth.)
- Take some seeds (fenugreek or coriander etc) and sow them in the soil.
- Sprinkle some water.
- Keep the pot under the sun light.
- Daily sprinkle water and observe.
- The seeds germinate and grow into small plants.
- Bring it to the school after holidays.
