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#### **1. Mini mythical champs:**

#### **Guidelines-**

1. Participants should wear appropriate costumes, make up and speak about the character.
2. Time duration- 2 minutes
3. Exceeding time will lead to disqualification.
4. Two participants for each category from each school.

**1. 'Find my 'PALM' (palm printing)**

**GUIDELINES:**

1. The participant is supposed to use only poster colours on their palms.

**1. Magic Wand**

**Guidelines:**

1. Child should be ready with the below mentioned material.
2. Time limit: 45 min

3. Material needed: plain mud pot (approx. 6" height), water colors, brushes, decorative materials and glue etc.

**Judgement criteria:**

2. Designing

**3. Paint your dream (Paint without using brush)**

**Guidelines:**

1. Child should not use brush to paint the given theme, instead they can use any other material such as their hand, thumb, vegetables etc.
2. Time limit: 30 min
3. Material needed: plain white A4 size paper
4. Water colors (do not use sketch pens, color pencils, crayons)

**Judgement criteria:**

1. Creativity
2. Originality

**4. Divine chant/Explore the Vedas (Shloka recitation):**

**Guidelines:**

1. Child can take any Sanskrit shlokas/ shlokas from Bhagavadgeetha
2. Shlokas must not be less than 12 lines.

**1. REGARD BEFORE YOU DISCARD**

**Guidelines:**

1. Team shall consist of two members only.
2. Participants will be given 1 hour to show their creativity and 2 minutes to talk about the same.
3. Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material or any second hand items.
4. The material would be rejected if not found to be a waste product or second hand item.
5. Readymade or semi-finished model or matter would not be accepted from participant in competition. The student has to do it instantly.
6. Participants will be judged on Creativity, Utilization of Resources, Artistic composition & design, Eco-friendly rating, Utility of the Product and Overall Presentation.
7. The decision of the judges will be considered final and abiding.

**2. Chisel your veggies:**

**Guidelines:**

1. Participants are required to provide their own working tools, fruits and vegetables to be used in the competition. No power tools allowed.
2. No pre-slicing, carving or preparation of vegetables before the competition. No mark or drawings should be visible on the fruit and vegetables. Coordinators and judges will check the materials before the start of competition. Any materials with marks or drawings will be taken out.

3. Only toothpicks are allowed to be used. Wire, glues and artificial coloring are not allowed.
4. Time allotment for the competition is two hours. Going beyond the allotted time will mean a penalty of one point per minute, which will be subtracted from the total score.
5. Participants should report 15 minutes prior to the start of the event.

4. Overall impression of the art.

### 3. The Browning Version: Monologue

#### **Guidelines:**

From Julius Caesar by William Shakespeare

In theatre, a monologue means a speech presented by a single character, most often to express their mental thoughts aloud, though sometimes also to directly address another character or the audience. Monologues are common across the range of dramatic media, as well as in non-dramatic media such as poetry. Monologues share much in common with several other literary devices including soliloquies, apostrophes, and asides. There are, however, distinctions between each of these devices.

#### **Judgment Criteria:**

1. Presentation
2. Outfit
3. Flow of words
4. Selection of monologue

### 4. Extempore

**Guidelines** - Extempore is a speech that is given on the spot without preparation. It is a test of your knowledge about a topic as well as your ability to express yourself in good words in a framed manner within a limited time.

#### **Judgment Criteria:**

1. Flow of thought / emotion
2. Use of vocabulary
3. Content
4. Presentation
