Sree Vidyanikethan International School has been ranked the No.1 Co-ed Boarding School in Andhra Pradesh with the highest score among other schools.

Dumpa Venkata Sai Tejeswara Reddy topped the All-India Secondary School Examination by scoring 97.4% and Dharmaram Nikhil Raghavendra topped the All-India Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination 2023-24 by scoring 94%.

Academics being the core of the school, SVIS believes in rendering child-centric education. Chrysalis Curriculum has been introduced for classes 1 to 5, to make education joyful and creative. Chrysalis Think room Program aims at awakening the human potential in every child by exploring competencies covering the cognitive, emotional and social domains of a child's learning.

Foundation Classes for classes 6 to 10 help the students master core subjects and guide them to opt for the subjects they desire to specialize in the future.

The Integrated Course for classes 11 and 12 benefits the students to qualify for examinations like IIT -JEE, NEET and EAMCET. A cohort of students had qualified in these competitive exams and are pursuing their dreams.

SVIS focuses on giving the best experiential learning to its students. Hands-on practice through discoveries and experiments, observation and interaction through fieldwork, bring the best outcomes in the teaching-learning process. The school has incorporated electronic devices like smart boards and tabs into the learning environment, wherein a physical classroom extends into a digital space. Sharing videos, worksheets, and presentations and conducting Daily Practise Tests through tabs, have made access to content at ease.

SVIS's bequest in creating scientific temper went one step ahead with the establishment of Atal Tinkering Laboratory, a workstation where children work with the latest technologies and tools like Robotics, electronics, sensors, open-source micro-controller boards, 3D printers etc., to understand the concepts of STEAM and to create technology innovations.

The inventive program 'DEAR- Drop Everything and Read', has helped students inculcate the habit of reading. Every person in the school drops everything and reads a book, devoting a good 80 minutes per week to reading, a step towards transforming trivial readers into avid readers.
